CONTEST RULES

1. All models MUST be the sole work of the contestant. Entries by proxy are welcomed. Please provide the builder’s name at registration.
2. Any model may be entered unless it is a previous ASMS Model Show or IPMS National winner.
3. Box stock categories may ONLY use parts provided in the kit. NO scratchbuilt parts, parts from other kits, or aftermarket parts may be used. Kit instructions MUST be on display with the model. Aftermarket decals are allowed.
4. “Scratchbuilt” models must be significantly derived from any existing kit to be considered as much.
5. Pre-painted models (PPM) are eligible in the Young Modelers categories ONLY. Contestant MUST designate the entry as PPM on the contest sheet. The use of photo-etched parts in Young Modelers categories is NOT allowed.
6. Non-diorama entries may include a base and crew-member. Neither will be judged.
7. Entry in the Collections and Dioramas categories can be the work of an individual or a group.
8. Collections are defined as any group of **five or more** closely related models.



9. **Three** models from different major categories, all built by the same modeler. Previous winners in solo categories are eligible in this category only.
10. All entries in the Figures category will be judged using the **Open System** where each contestant’s work is evaluated on its own merit instead of against others in the same division. Contestants are welcomed to enter as many figures as he/she wishes in both **Painters** and **Open** divisions.

Judging in the **Painters Division** is based entirely upon painting skill regardless of any alteration to the figure and the base work. In the **Open Division**, the skill and imagination of the contestant’s scratch-building and conversion abilities as well as the base work are the primary factors of judging.

All entries in the Painter and Open divisions will be evaluated, and each contestant’s best figure will be used to qualify for **ONE OVERALL** Gold, Silver, or Bronze award in **each respective division**.

11. ASMS reserves the right to split contest categories at our discretion.
12. Questions and disputes over model eligibility, category placement, and judging criteria are to be referred to the Head Judge at the event. **The decision of the Head Judge is final... NCB!**
13. **Road Less Traveled Award:** for most unusual or hardest to build aircraft subject, as selected by sponsor **Phil Brandt**.
14. **On Her Majesty’s Service Award** for the best model of materiel in service to the British Crown since 1952, sponsored by **Eric Choy**.
15. **Sixty Years But Not Forgotten Award** for the best Korean War armor model, sponsored by **Pat Rourke**.
16. **Best Star Trek/Star Wars Model Award**, sponsored by Jeff Forster.

Contestants are encouraged to attach their models to bases. The judges will make every effort not to touch the models, however, category splits and crowding often make this impossible. No model will be assumed to be attached to the base!

ASMS requests that participants do not display entries that depict extreme violence, sexual acts, or other offensive subjects.

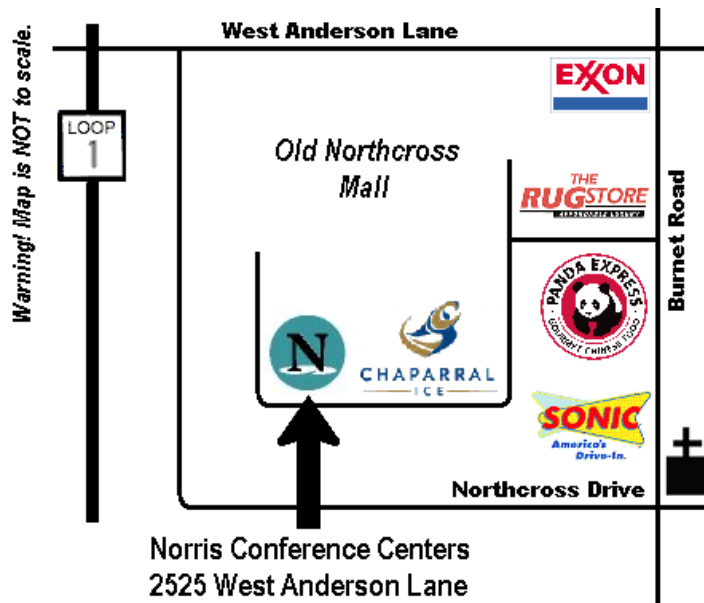
Vendor Info

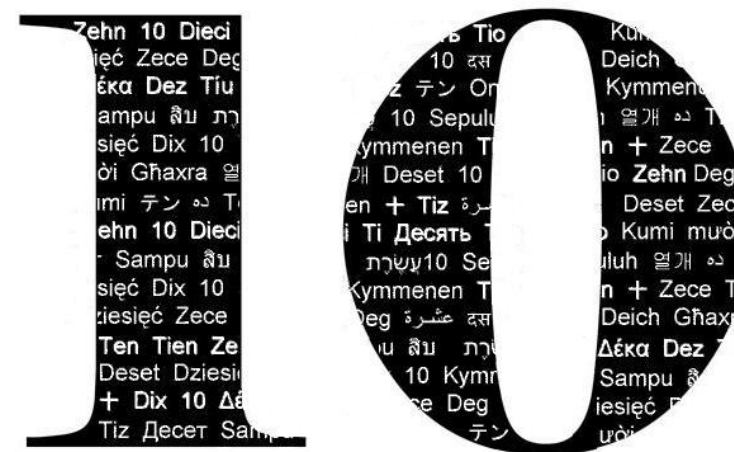
