CONTEST RULES

1. All models MUST be the contestant’s sole work (see rule 7 for exception). Entries by proxy are welcomed.
2. Any model may be entered unless it is a previous ASMS Model Show winner (see rule 8 for exception).
3. Box stock categories may ONLY use parts provided in the kit. NO scratchbuilt parts, parts from other kits, or aftermarket parts may be used. Kit instructions MUST be on display with the model. Aftermarket decals are allowed. There is no limitation on type/era/scale.
4. Scratchbuilt models must NOT significantly derive from any existing kit.

5. Pre-painted models are eligible in the Young Modeler category ONLY. Contestant MUST designate the entry as such on the contest sheet. The use of photo-etched parts in the Young Modeler category is NOT allowed.
6. A non-diorama entry may include a base and crew member(s). Neither will be judged.
7. A **Collection** is defined as any group of **five or more** closely related models. Entries in this category can be the work of an individual or a group.
8. **Three** models from different major categories, all built by the same modeler. Previous winners in solo categories are eligible in this category only.
9. A **Miniature Army** is defined as any group of **five or more** closely related gaming miniatures. Judging is based on painting skill and the size of the army.
10. **On Her Majesty’s Service Award** sponsored by Eric Choy for the best model of materiel in service to the British Crown since 1952.
11. **Best Submersible Model** for the best model of any subject that operates below the surface of water.
12. **Best Automotive Powertrain** sponsored by Mike Poole for the best non-military automotive engine.
13. **Best Warhammer Subject** sponsored by Aaron Smischney for the best Warhammer or W40K model.
14. **Best Star Trek Model** sponsored by Jeff Forster.
15. **Best Competition Model** sponsored by Jeff Forster.
16. **Best USMC Aircraft Model** sponsored by Mike Krizan.
17. **Best 1950’s USAF Interceptor** sponsored by Jack Johnston for the best model of any active (no experimental) USAF interceptor used during the ’50s.
18. **Best Air Racer Model** sponsored by Williams Brothers Model Products.
19. **Road Less Traveled Award** for the most unusual or hardest to build aircraft model in memory of “Bondo” Phil Brandt.

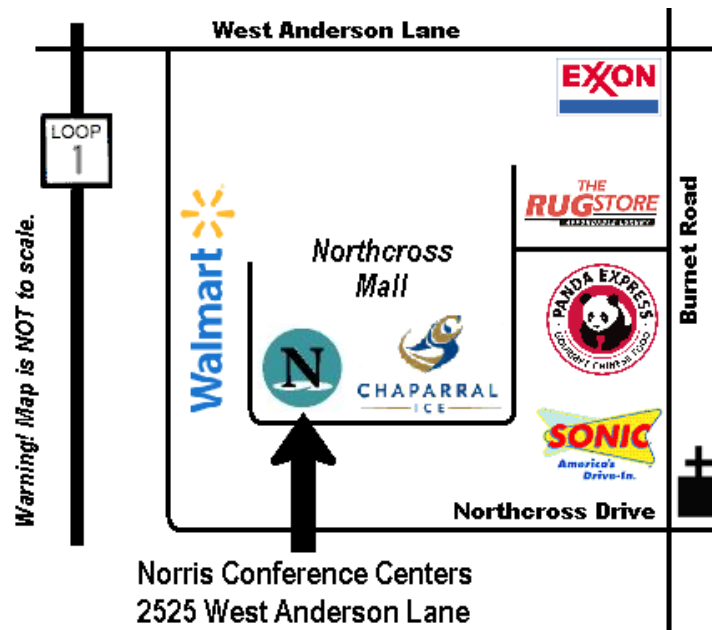
