**NOTE:** Gundam Categories will be judged on a point system instead of IPMS style. Points given for build 40%, finish 40%, and presentation 20%. Awards will be given to first, second, and third place winners.

## **700: FIGURES**

**NOTE:** Judging will be done by Open System (aka “Chicago Style”) with gold, silver, and bronze awards.

701: Painters Division (Only figure will be judged).

702: Open Division (Everything, including figure and groundwork, on the base will be judged).

## **800: MISCELLANEOUS**

801: Collection (Any group of 5 or more closely related models. Entries can be the work of an individual or a group.)

802: Triathlon (Three models from different major categories, all built by the same modeler. Previous winners in solo categories are eligible in this category only.)

803: Miniature Army (Any group of five or more closely related gaming miniatures. Judging is based on painting skill and the size of the army.)

804: I’ve Improved! – a model kit built approximately ten plus years ago entered along with a recently completed model built from the same kit. This category will be judged on most improvement shown between old and recently built models.

805: Miscellaneous Biological
